

Highlights from the Governance Team Meeting December 4, 2006

CLC Outcomes, Key Performance Indicators and Measures

The Governance Team is continuing their work on developing a bank of measures for each of the Key Performance Indicators under the four CLC Outcomes. At this meeting the Governance Team again, reviewed a draft of Key Performance Indicators of Outcome 3: Create a campus that encompasses and promotes environmental sustainability. This review included the suggestions made by the Governance Team at the last meeting.

Project and Budget Status Report

A status report on the schedule and budget was provided. The budget has changed to include recent tender results and cost estimates since the last meeting. The tender for the foundation and steel for the Fine Arts Facility came in slightly under budget.

CLC Program Development Committee

The Program Development Committee has been working on number important initiatives:

1. Community Input Survey

This survey has been mailed to residents of Olds and surrounding area. The purpose of the survey is to gather data on community programming needs. The summarizing of the data obtained from this survey will begin this month.

2. The Transition Pilot Program

A meeting is being organized with service organizations to determine opportunities for mentorship and service learning for learners. This meeting will set out opportunities for the service organization to either mentor students or provide project work with which students can help.

3. Renewable Energy Project

The “Renewable Energy Project” Working Group is working on making connections between the Olds College School of Innovation Bio-diesel project and the high school curriculum. This committee will be chaired by Tanya MacDonald from the School of Innovation.

4. Green Project

The “Green Project” will focus on using the design and construction phase of the CLC as projects for Olds College and Olds High School learners, with possible connections to other Chinook’s Edge learners. This working group will be chaired by Carole Calenso-Fair, Chair of the School of Horticulture. Areas of interest for this group will include landscaping, the green roofs and the gateways to the CLC.

5. Technology

There was a two day Technology Plan Workshop facilitated by Dr. Tom Keenan from the University of Calgary. Participants focused on how technology will advance the CLC programs. P. Bidart and D. Negropontes will work to add substance to the ideas that were generated toward the design of a CLC Technology Plan.



CLC Facility Use Committee

The Facility Use Committee has been meeting on a regular basis and is currently focusing on the guiding principles for both the use of the facilities and for the lease tenants.

CLC Business Development Committee

The Business Development Committee has been working over the last month on making contacts with potential donors. Considerable interest has been expressed in the project.

CLC Olds College Faculty and Staff Update

Two noon hour presentations were made for the Olds College Faculty and Staff on November 24 and 30. The drawings were available as were documents for each person to take away with them. Participants were encouraged to identify potential areas of interest in the Transition Project. D. Negropontes, D. Shaw, P. Bidart and T. Christensen each presented to the groups. As there was not a lot of time for questions, D. Negropontes will be making arrangements to be available in each of the five schools during a noon hour to answer questions that people may have.
