

**Highlights from the Governance Team Meeting
September 4, 2007**

Project and Budget Status Report

The Governance Team was given the August 13, 2007 budget figures and viewed a power point presentation on where the project is as of September 4, 2007.

Executive Director's Report

D. Negropontes will be participating, as a speaker, in a number of upcoming conferences: The Future of Rural Alberta, The Council of Facilities Planner International and Distributed Learning. The CLC is working with the U of C, the Van Horne Institute, Olds College and CESD to present the "Communities Without Boundaries" Conference on Nov 1 and 2 to be held at Olds College. D. Negropontes has been establishing CLC connections with the Community Adult Programming, the Hanna Learning Centre, Community Futures and Alberta North.

CLC Program Development Committee

There will be special meeting of the Program Committee on June 11, 2007 to review the past year and to make plans for the upcoming year.

The Transition Pilot Program

This coming year the challenge of providing a clear picture of what is available for high school students will be a focus for the Program Committee. The *Introduction to Horses* course which was so successful last year will be offered again this year.

Renewable Energy Project

This successful committee is working on plans to host the Applied Research Seminar for the second year.

Green Space

This group will resume meetings this fall and will begin planning the landscaping of the CLC providing learning opportunities for high school and college students

Integrated Career Centre

This group met with Dr. Bryan Hiebert from the U of C to discuss how career services can be delivered in a comprehensive manner.

Library Integration

A draft Memorandum of Understanding between Olds College and Chinook's Edge School Division will be reviewed by the Executive Committee.

Community Engagement Sites

We are waiting word from the Rural Alberta's Development Fund regarding possible funding for the CES project. Two classroom in Bowden and Cremona are being converted to CES to provide videoconferencing.



CLC Facility Use Committee

The Facility Use Committee is working on a number of agreements regarding the facilities, including rental agreements for the theatre. The committee is working through budget projections on the cost of operating the facilities through joint operating principles. They have been working on security for the high school as well as the other facilities.

CLC Business Development Committee

The campaign goal of \$5M is currently at \$2.8M. The theatre seat campaign has raised \$35 882.86, \$23 000 of which have come from the Kiwanis. The Kiwanis are hosting a reception on September 14, 2007 in the Faculty Centre of Olds College to promote the theatre seat campaign.
