



## **Highlights from the Governance Team Meeting October 5, 2009**

### **Project and Budget Status Report**

There have been no changes to the budget since the Governance Team meeting of September 8, 2009. An updated report on the budget should be available by November 2009. The CLC remains committed to a balanced budget.

### **Executive Director's Report**

Construction continues at the Core High School and Health & Wellness Centre; these facilities are approximately 85% complete. Landscaping work is ongoing and includes the testing of various plant materials on the green roof areas. Exterior light standards are currently being installed outside of the Fine Arts & Multi Media and the Core High School and Health & Wellness Centre. Users and patrons will find illumination in the parking lots adjacent to these facilities greatly improved. The wooden flooring for the gymnasium in the Core High School will be installed later this month. The bleachers and rubberized track are scheduled to be installed in November and December respectively. The Community Engagement Sites in Bowden, Delburne, Sundre, Red Deer, and Innisfail are all operational. The Community Engagement Site in Cremona is temporarily out of service due to construction renovations currently taking place at the Cremona school. The Engagement Sites in Spruce View, Penhold, and Elnora will be opening later on in the winter. A delegation from the University of Alberta was in attendance for the October 5, 2009, Governance Team Meeting. The group gave a presentation on the 'Rural Experiential Learning Initiative' pilot project.

### **Events**

Alberta Arts Days celebrations were held at the Fine Arts & Multi Media Centre on September 19, 2009. This event showcased the depth and variety of talent located right here in Central Alberta. A sold out crowd took in the free evening concert featuring Gord Bamford, The Polyjesters, and Jenn Beaupre.
