Highlights from the Governance Team Meeting March 3, 2008

CLC Bell e-Learning Centre Grand Opening

1. The date for the Grand Opening has been revised as October 3, 2008.
2. Program and details of the day will be presented through CLC Executive to CESD and OC for feedback.

CONFERENCES, PRESENTATIONS, and TOURS

1. February 5, 2008 – Patci Hopkins, DTHR, Reducing Barriers to Healthy Living met with D. Negroptes regarding the needs assessment they are doing with Neighbourhood Place.
2. February 20, 2008 – D. Negroptes did a presentation at the Rural Team Alberta (RTAB) Learning Event in Edmonton. The Federal Rural Secretariat, and Alberta Employment, Immigration and Industry are the sponsors of this event. There were presentations on rural community learning, rural connectivity, engaging rural communities in economic development issues, building the capacity of women in Alberta's trade industry, and assisting communities with local arts and heritage events.

CONSTRUCTION

Bell e-Learning Centre

1. We have control of this facility as the final inspection has been completed.
2. Deficiencies are being addressed.
3. Bell network installation has begun.

Health & Wellness Facility and the Core High School

1. Received the last of the structural steel except columns and beams for the gyms.
2. Roofing on the high school section has started.
3. Temporary heat is on and the building is enclosed by tarps and some walls.
4. Steel is going up for the Health and Wellness and then the last stairwell will be underway.
5. Gymnasiums will start to go up in the next two weeks.

Fine Arts and Multi-Media Centre

1. Interior dry walling and masonry are almost complete.
2. There has been some painting in some areas. (We are very pleased with the quality of the painting and we have the same painter on all the buildings.)
3. The curtain wall glass will be installed in the second week of March along with all the other windows.

1. Nothing new to report until spring work begins.
2. Landscape Charrette follow-up being developed and we are exploring to what degree we will complete the landscaping.

CTS Shop Renovation

1. We are waiting for the plans to be submitted to Executive Committee for approval.

FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT

1. First review of all building complete.
2. We are revisiting fine arts, core high school and health and wellness buildings looking for savings.
3. Bell e-Learning
 - Purchasing for the e-Learning almost complete.
 - Furniture and equipment is mostly here.
 - Computers are being unpacked and installed.
 - Testing of technology will begin in March.
