Project and Budget Status Report

The budget for the Community Learning Campus project remains balanced at approximately \$68.5 million dollars.

Executive Director's Report and Community Engagement Site Report

Construction is underway at the food kiosk area in the Ralph Klein Centre, which houses Olds High School, health and wellness services, as well as the offices of Central Alberta Child and Family Services Authority and Alberta Employment and Immigration (also known as Alberta Works). Temporary food service is being provided until the kiosk space has been completed. Progress also continues at the fitness centre, where equipment has been ordered and audio-visual details are being finalized. The anticipated completion date for both the fitness centre and the food kiosk is June 2010. Site cleanup and landscaping work are ongoing.

The Community Engagement Site Coordinators have been offering a number of new programs for rural community members. The sites are now certified BOATsmart Canada affiliates, offering both the Pleasure Craft Operator Card exam and the Safe Boating Course. Other programs being delivered via the Community Engagement Sites include Simply Accounting, Excel, and Computer Basics. Usage at all of the sites has been steadily increasing, and planning for next years' programming is already underway. The Engagement Sites in the communities of Carstairs and Penhold are currently being finalized, while planning continues for the sites in Didsbury and Sylvan Lake.

At this time, the members would like to recognize Allan Tarnoczi for his hard work and dedication as the CLC Community Engagement Site Project Manager. Allan has recently taken on a new role as Associate Superintendent for Chinook's Edge School Division. His commitment to the CLC project will be missed and we wish him every success in his new position.
